SECTION B — CAMP RULES & SAFETY STANDARDS

The FHN Day Camp provides an immersive STEM, leadership, and academic literacy experience. Because activities include hands-on construction, circuitry, and structured experiments, all scholars are required to adhere strictly to the following rules to ensure the safety and success of every participant. Please read each section carefully.

1. STEM Lab & Equipment Safety

1. Always wear safety goggles and any other required PPE before beginning any hands-on STEM experiment or lab activity.
2. Never touch, activate, or modify electrical circuits, chemical substances, or mechanical equipment without explicit staff authorization.
3. Handle all tools — including soldering irons, wire cutters, and scissors — only as directed and return them immediately after use.
4. Report any broken equipment, exposed wiring, or unsafe conditions to a staff member immediately. Do NOT attempt to fix it yourself.
5. No horseplay, running, or roughhousing in any lab or workspace area.

2. General Conduct & Respect

1. Treat all scholars, staff, volunteers, and facility personnel with courtesy and respect at all times.
2. Bullying, harassment, intimidation, or discriminatory language of any kind will result in immediate removal from camp.
3. Maintain a phone-free focus during all instruction periods. Devices must be silenced and stored unless a staff member grants permission.
4. Respect all camp facilities, equipment, and materials. You are responsible for any damage caused by intentional misuse.
5. Follow all instructions from FHN staff and YMCA facility staff promptly and without argument.

3. Attendance & Movement

1. Scholars must remain within designated camp areas at all times. Do NOT leave the designated space without a staff escort.
2. Notify a staff member immediately if you feel ill, need to use the restroom, or need to leave the group for any reason.
3. Be present and on time for all scheduled sessions. Tardiness disrupts the learning environment for all scholars.

4. Substance & Safety Policy

1. No tobacco products, alcohol, illegal substances, or weapons of any kind are permitted on camp premises.
2. Do not bring, share, or administer any medication to another scholar. All medications must go through the camp health coordinator.

5. Consequences

1. Minor infractions: verbal warning, followed by written notice to parent/guardian.
2. Moderate infractions: parent/guardian contact, mandatory reflection meeting with staff.
3. Severe infractions (safety violations, violence, threats): immediate removal from camp. No refunds will be issued.
